

What is recyclable?

While we can't list every item, ecomaine has provided us with some guidelines.

Paper products

Cardboard/all boxes cut down
maximum size 18" x 24"
Newspaper
Shoe boxes/ cereal boxes
Magazines / catalogs
File folders
Gift boxes / wrap
Shopping bags
Aseptic milk & juice cartons
All books, including phone books
Junk mail/window envelopes

Plastic, Metal & Glass

All plastics labeled #1-7
Foil
Cans
Pots & pans
Empty aerosol cans
Jars
Empty bottles (any color glass)

Plastic food containers typically have the recycle triangle molded into the bottom of the container, with a number 1 through 7 in the center of the triangle. If your plastic materials don't have the recycle triangle with the number, then that item is not recyclable at this time. Some plastic wrapping on things that we purchase will have the recycle triangle and the number printed on them, if that number is a 1 through 7 then that material is recyclable.
