POLICY #12

TOWN OF HOLLIS POLLING PLACE PETITION POLICY

- I) Space within the voting area, i.e. building or outside area around building, will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis. Space for petitioners will never interrupt the flow of voters or the voting process. Petitioners shall make a request for space with the Town Clerk no later than the Friday before each election.
- 2) The presiding Election Warden/Moderator or Town Clerk will be responsible for placement of all petitioners and their deportment. Petitioners shall remain in the area assigned to them. All Petitioners must stay at their tables; beside or behind their designated area.
- 3) Petitioners will be required to furnish their own table and chairs. Only one adult is allowed per table during election hours. Minors at a petition table must have an adult present.
- 3) Upon approval of the Town Clerk, Petitioners may have a poster of 8 1/2" x 11" attached to their table indicating the purpose of their petition. (Political parties are not permitted signage unless approved by the State Election Office).
- 4). Voters will only be available to petitioners on the way out of the polls, and only if Voters choose to approach the petition area. All Petitioners must follow the guidelines set out in Election laws.
- 5) All political signage and advertising must remain outside of 250' feet of the polls while any voting is in process this includes absentee voting and early voting if applicable.
- 6) The Designated Election Official for each election will have full authority to evict petitioners who choose to violate this policy or any applicable election laws.
